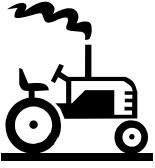


Here's How You Can Help Us Impact Our Community...

Choose from TWO ways to give to Cornell Cooperative Extension of Steuben County

1. Distribute my gift among the following needs: (if choosing more than one, indicate amount for each)
 If combined gifts exceed the need for the item indicated, we will apply excess to needs in the same program unless otherwise specified.



- \$1,000 for lap top computer. Need 8-12 sponsors to create a computer lab for our clients.
 (would use for 4-H, nutrition and agriculture training)
- \$500-1,000 to research red clover rotation crop varieties to prevent root lesion nematodes and other diseases common to potatoes. Higher yields are the best hope of sustaining the potato farms in Steuben County.
- \$150 for portable printer for agriculture staff to use in conducting on-farm analysis reports.



- \$1,000 for Operation Front Line classes which team a local chef, community agency and Share Our Strength to help families help themselves by learning how to prepare healthy low cost meals.
- \$1,000 start up funds for providing Small Steps to Health and Wealth to the general population of Steuben County that is not served by our grant. Combo of nutrition and financial management classes.
- \$500 for 50 Class Kits to encourage nutrition class participants to use their new skills for cooking healthy meals.
- \$300 for food preservation equipment. This will allow us to hold food preservation classes in additional locations.



- \$250 for advertising to make people aware of financial counseling services.
- \$250 for 25 decks of Teen Habitude Cards which train teens on how to understand their financial tendencies.
- \$50 for 10 Class Kits to encourage financial class participants to use their new skills to keep control of their budgets (items such as calculator, file organizer, memo pad, cardboard "where to find the money" calculator).
- \$50 for Digital ATM Machine to teach credit use to financial participants.
- \$25 for 10 Cardboard Calculators for budgeting clients.
- \$25 for energy gifts to encourage people to attend Energy Workshops to save energy dollars.



- \$500 for plants for a Master Gardener Demonstration Garden (for education and community beautification).
- \$250 for Master Gardener training and continuing education.
- \$300 for resources for the Master Gardener Library.
- \$200 to underwrite speakers for community development education.
- \$100 for recognition of current Master Gardener work.



- \$1,500 for summer 4-H assistant position to work with summer youth throughout county.
- \$1,500 for electrical wiring at fairgrounds for PA system in the horse ring announcer stand.
- \$1,500 for PVC panel fence in the animal science program at the fairgrounds.
- \$100 for Improved Rabbit Cages at the fairgrounds.
- \$30 for horse height measuring stick for Horse Shows.
- Donation of a location to hold dog obedience training indoors year-round.

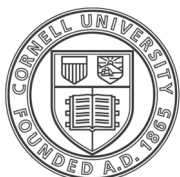
