

**COUNTY FAIR INFORMATION FOR 4-H MEMBERS EXHIBITING MARKET ANIMALS**

**WEIGHING 4-H LIVESTOCK ENTRIES**

All 4-H market lambs, hogs, goats and steers to be exhibited at the County Fair must be weighed at Empire Livestock before arriving on the fairgrounds. Empire Livestock has excellent facilities and your market animals will be weighed properly. The weight at Empire will be the official weight used for class breaks for the show and for the Livestock Sale. If an eartag falls out of an animal the CCE Office must be notified so that a member of the 4-H Livestock Committee can come and make a farm visit even if the tag that you will be replacing is the same number. If an animal comes to Empire without permanent identification in it's ear that matches the ID form, the animal will be disqualified and unable to be brought to the county fair.

**EVERY ANIMAL MUST BE TAGGED WITH A 4-H EAR TAG BEFORE WEIGH IN.**

Empire Livestock is located on route 415 approximately two miles north of Bath headed towards Kanona. Animals can be weighed at **Empire on Monday August 16 from 8 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. only.** The animals need to be on the fairgrounds by **5:00 p.m. on Monday August 16.** If your truckers need to make two trips please make arrangements to have them stay within the time specifications. Please stay within these time frames. Empire Livestock's number is 607-776-2000. ***ABSOLUTELY NO ANIMALS WILL BE ACCEPTED AT EMPIRE AFTER 4:00 P.M.***

Reminder: There will be no veterinarians available at the Fairgrounds AFTER 5:00 p.m.. on Monday August 16<sup>th</sup>, therefore no animals can be unloaded after 5:00 p.m..
