- Cloverbud members may enter in the youth building 5 entries per exhibitor and one group project. All Cloverbud projects are entered in Department X, Section VI of the County Fair book.
- Complete green entry tag for each youth building entry and attach securely. Pins, tape, string, etc. can be used to attach.
- Cloverbuds may exhibit 1 animal ONLY in 4-H classes. Refer to the Steuben County Fair 4-H Cloverbud Livestock Fair book for more information.
- **NEW: Bring Non-Animal entries to the 4-H building at the County Fair on Sunday, August 14<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. only.**
- **4-H members will present and talk individually to the judge about their projects.**
- Participation ribbons will be awarded and the Cloverbud youth building projects will be on display in a special section during the Steuben County Fair.
- Cloverbud 4-H building exhibits will not be released until **7:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 21<sup>st</sup> or from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. on Monday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> at the fairgrounds. All 4-H exhibits must be picked up by 11:00 a.m. on Monday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>.**
