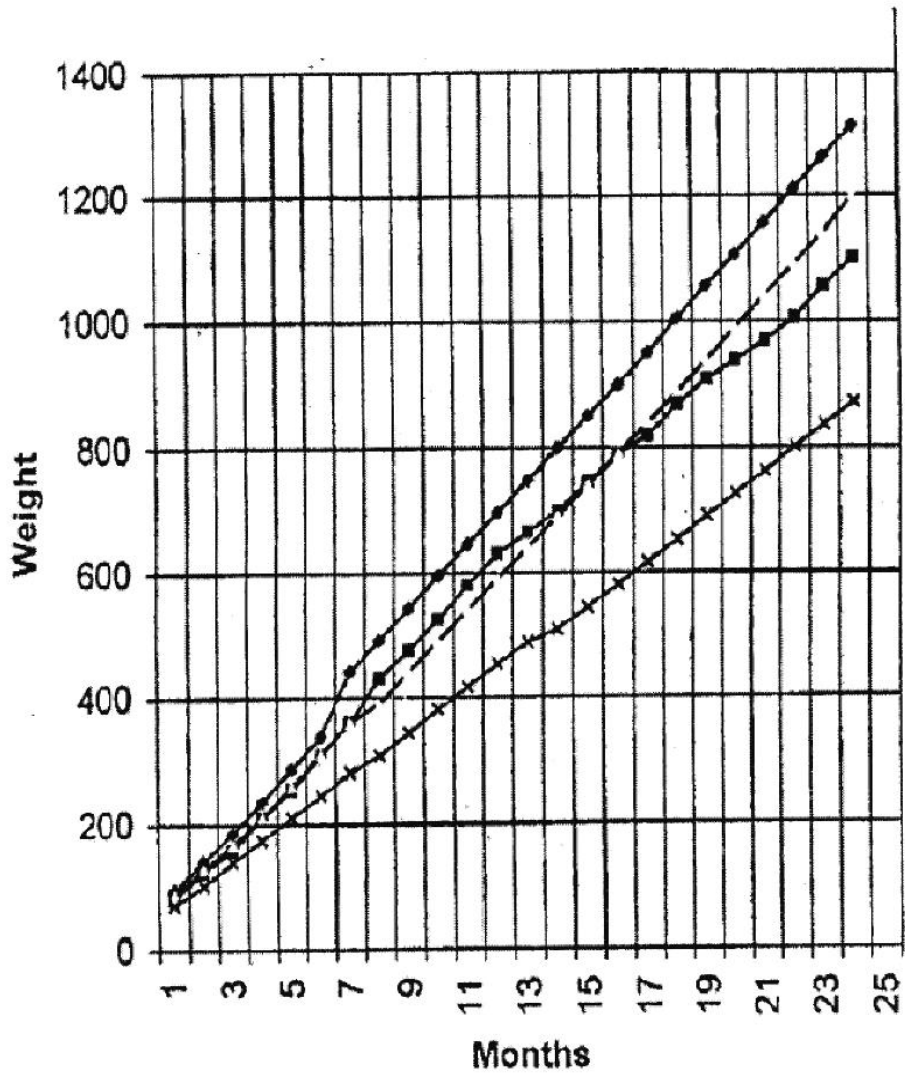

Heifer Growth Chart



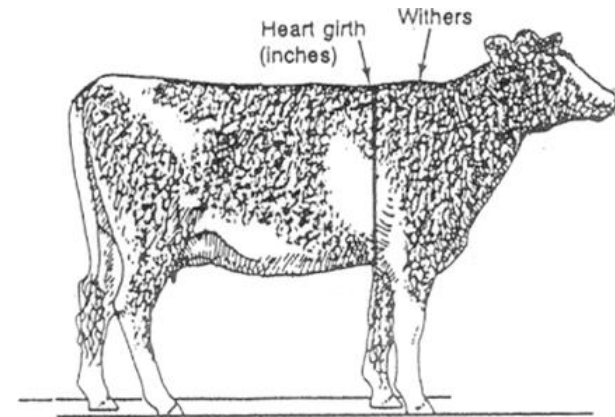
